Save Your Oak Trees Before It's Too Late!

Oak wilt disease is already killing trees in Niagara Falls and Niagara on the Lake, Ontario, just across the river.

Now is the time to vaccinate your high valued oak trees to prevent infection.

What You Need to Know

• Oak wilt is a devastating fungal disease that has killed millions of oak trees in the Midwest and South. Western New York is in the crosshairs with the biggest threat coming from just across the river in Canada. The disease is carried by small sap beetles.



Sap beetles spread oak wilt disease.

- There are two primary ways to protect your oak trees from infection. First, you can get your oak trees vaccinated with a special fungicide (that's what we do)! Second, do not cut or trim your oak trees in the spring or summer. Sap beetles are attracted to exposed wood. If your trees are storm damaged, it's important to seal the wounds immediately with latex paint.
- In most instances, it's more cost effective to keep your oak trees healthy than it is to cut them down after they are dead. Tree removal can cost thousands of dollars.
