# Save Your Oak Trees Before It's Too Late!

Oak wilt disease has already killed trees in Niagara Falls and Niagara-on-the-Lake, Ontario, just across the river.

Now is the time to vaccinate your high valued oak trees to prevent infection.

## What You Need to Know

- Oak wilt is a devastating and invasive fungal disease (there's no cure) that has killed millions of oak trees in the Midwest and South. Western New York is in the crosshairs with the biggest threat coming from just across the river in Canada. Spread by small sap beetles, the disease poses a critical threat to areas like Youngstown, Lewiston, Niagara Falls and Grand Island. See the map on the back of this flyer. You can see oak wilt edging closer. NY DEC has set up beetle traps in Youngstown and Niagara Falls to monitor the oak wilt threat.
- You can prevent oak wilt by getting your high-valued trees vaccinated with a special fungicide — that's what we do. Vaccinations can only be administered by state licensed applicators and offer 2-3 years of protection.
- Keeping Niagara and Erie Counties free of oak wilt is a community effort. Please don't cut or trim your oak trees in the Spring or Summer because it will attract sap beetles. If your trees are storm damaged, seal the wounds immediately with latex paint. If you see a tree that has lost leaves at the very top, please let us know..
- Prevention is key! Once oak wilt hits, countless oaks will be lost. In most instances, it's more cost effective to keep your high-valued trees healthy than it is to cut them down after they're dead. Tree removal of mature trees can cost thousands of dollars.
